Society Fact Sheet

The 2013 National LWML Convention to be held in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania will be sponsored jointly by a coalition of LWML Districts (Atlantic, Eastern, English, New England, New Jersey, and SELC). To raise funds to cover expenses, these districts are encouraging their societies to participate in a recycling campaign which will have the added benefit of preserving God's creation. LWML members are urged to elicit support from fellow church members, co-workers, friends, family, neighbors, and local businesses by asking them to save items.

*Virgin cartridges are those that are not remanufactured or refilled by companies such as Office Depot, Office Max, Staples, or Walgreen's.

How Should Individual Items Be Packaged for Collection?

Pack cartridges in the original box whenever possible. Or, place in a plastic zip-lock bag to guard against leakage.

What Should We Do With the Items Collected?

Bring them to your Zone's collection site at designated times. Facilitators in each Zone will assume responsibility for processing and shipping your items. **Societies are NOT to secure pre-paid labels and ship their items.** Contact your Zone President for details regarding deposit location and/or personnel involved with this facet of the program.

How Can We Publicize the Effort?

- Make announcements.
- Post flyers on bulletin boards in church, at work, and in the community.
- Place information in your church newsletter and/or bulletin using the inserts provided.
